American Heart Association HeartCode® Basic Life Support for Healthcare Provider (BLS-P) 2025 Guidelines

Course Aim:

Basic Life Support (BLS) training aims to equip individuals with essential skills to recognize cardiac arrest, provide immediate and life sustaining care. The course focuses on high-quality CPR for all ages, the use of AED, and relieve choking, thereby acting as the crucial first link in the “chain of survival”.

The HeartCode BLS is a blended-learning course that combines self-paced online learning with hands-on practice and testing of BLS skills. The online portion uses a personalized adaptive algorithm, guiding students on the most efficient path to mastering BLS skills. Through this adaptive learning experience, students engage with various instructional formats, including dramatizations, animations, self-directed learning, and interactive activities.

Intended Audience:

Healthcare providers (doctors, nurses, paramedics, students) and trained first responders who may need to manage cardiac/respiratory emergencies in both hospital and pre-hospital settings.


