Professor Colin Graham came to the Accident and Emergency Medicine Academic Unit at the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 2004; he was promoted to Professor in 2007 and was appointed Director of the Unit in 2015. He has broad research interests within emergency medicine and has published widely. He was Editor-in-Chief of the European Journal of Emergency Medicine from 2009 until 2019 and served on the Executive and Council of the European Society for Emergency Medicine during that time.

He serves as council member of the Hong Kong College of Emergency Medicine in 2014-2019 and 2020-2021, and has been one of the advisors of the Research Subcommittee of the College since 2020.

Government Flying Service (GFS) is one of the disciplinary units supporting Hong Kong Road Rescues. In 2008, Auxiliary Medical Unit was commenced with the motto "Bring Aid to the patient", and now there are around 50 flying doctors have various specialties and also emergency nurses providing auxiliary medical services. Working out of hospital with the various adverse environment and medical resources is unique and challenging, both physically and mentally. The team witnessed many successful rescue missions, but also experienced some near-fatal rescue.
