Professor Colin Graham came to the Accident and Emergency Medicine Academic Unit at the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 2004; he was promoted to Professor in 2007 and was appointed Director of the Unit in 2015. He has broad research interests within emergency medicine and has published widely. 
