Hong Kong College of Emergency Medicine (HKCEM)

Guidelines on Certification for Specialist Registration (CSR) / Certification for Specialist Qualification (CSQ)

- The applicant must have completed a recognized specialist training program in Emergency Medicine and be currently a registered specialist in Emergency Medicine in the country where he / she had the Emergency Medicine training.
- 2. The applicant for CSR/CSQ should have gone through a training programme that is comparable with the specialist training programme of HKCEM, with at least 6 years of training that includes a minimum of 3 years A&E training (of which 2 years must be after passing an intermediate examination in Emergency Medicine recognized by HKCEM), half year of post-graduate training in acute surgical stream and half year of post-graduate training in acute non-surgical stream.
- 3. The applicant should have passed the Intermediate Examination recognized by HKCEM, together with an Exit Assessment of the relevant national College or accrediting body, before the issue of the Certificates of Specialists.
- 4. The applicant should provide relevant documents to demonstrate that the training he/he has received includes supervised on-job training, attendance of courses and workshops that are essential for Emergency Medicine training, work place-based assessment, and research training including conduction of research project.
- 5. The applicant may be required to attend an interview to assess his / her training and experience to the satisfaction of the Council of the HKCEM
