ECCI Sedation and Analgesia for Emergency Procedures 2024

Proper training for practitioners involved in procedural sedation is essential according to the 2020 HKAM Guidelines on Procedural Sedation. This half-day course focuses on the essential principles, pharmacology, and common pitfalls involving procedural sedation in emergency medicine setting.
